- Members are asked for their comments and feedback this evening on what the scheme should contain and those comments will feed into a detailed report to a later Committee meeting.

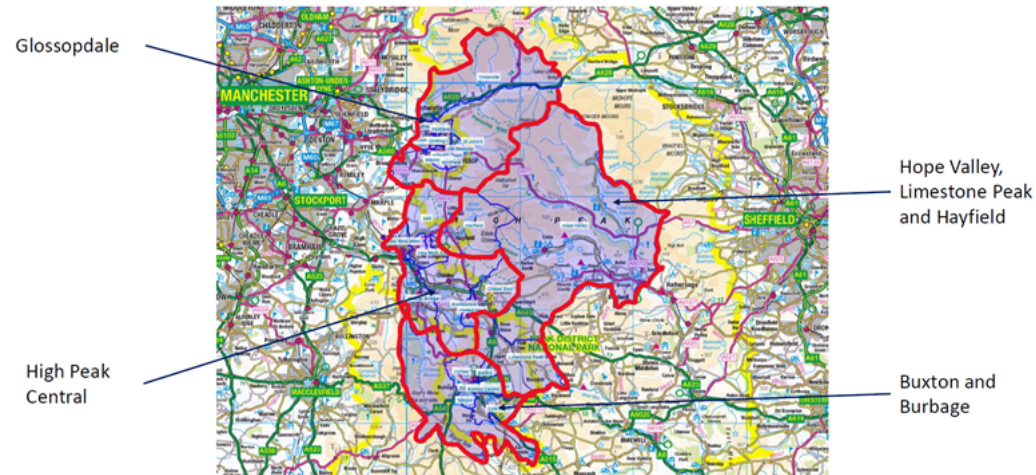
Overview

- Use of Member Initiative Scheme
- Providing IT resources
- Introduction of a case management system
- Locality analysis

Locality Analysis

- **Buxton and Burbage:** Barms, Burbage, Buxton Central, Corbar, Cote Heath, Stone Bench, Temple
- **High Peak Central:** Blackbrook, Chapel East, Chapel West, New Mills East, New Mills West, Sett, Whaley Bridge
- **Hope Valley, Limestone Peak and Hayfield**
- **Glossopdale:** Dinting, Gamesley, Hadfield North, Hadfield South, Howard Town, Old Glossop, Padfield, Simmondley, St John's, Tintwistle, Whitfield



Locality Analysis

Aim is to provide an initial starting point for discussions about the needs of different places in the High Peak.

- **Communities** - age, qualifications, deprivation, health, crime, fuel poverty
- **Place** – jobs, business, housing
- **Environment** – travel, landscape, green spaces, carbon emissions
