Biddulph: Biddulph East, Biddulph Moor, Biddulph North, Biddulph South, Biddulph West

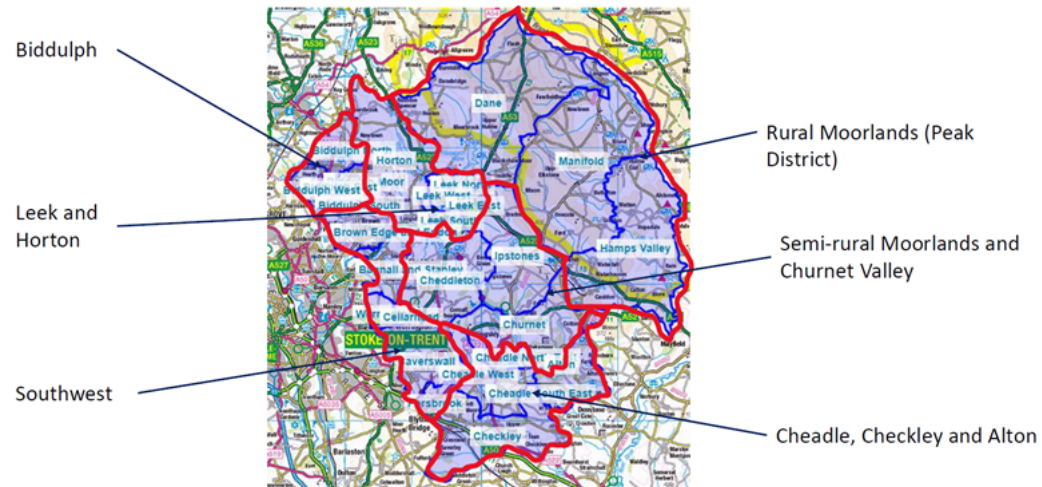
Leek and Horton: Leek East, Leek North, Leek South, Leek West, Horton
